Rocket Safety

Have fun and be responsible!

Consistent with Chapter 12 of the BSA Shooting Sports Manual:

- **Have a marked range.** The range must meet the criteria of a safe range: safe area, safe distance, and safe backstop. The range must be established. Make certain that no one will wander into the landing zone of the projectiles.
- **A range master must supervise the range. This person must be different than the adult helping launch the water rockets.**
- **Approved safety glasses or goggles** and other appropriate protective gear must be worn by anyone on the range when the rocket is being prepared for and is launched.
- Do not aim any shooting device at a person. Never shoot any projectile, even if it is soft or seems to be harmless, at or near people, animals, or personal property.
- A water rocket launcher is not a toy.
